### **PRODUCT REVIEW: The AirRevolution Air Pump by Mini Foot Pump**

We think it may be the last air pump we'll ever buy.



When we first saw the AirRevolution by Mini Foot Pump, we thought “It would be so cool if that thing worked, it’s so small.”

We were using the standard 2 foot bicycle pump, it’s so old school!! And it’s a flimsy thing too. Half the time we forget it because it’s too awkward to store in the truck. So we’ll try anything at his point.

We spoke with Niko Ackermann of Mini Foot Pump and he promised we wouldn’t have the same problems with this unit. That is was totally different that what we had been using.

When we got the unit we were surprised there was even a pump in the box, it was that small. There are actually 2 models, the MiniFootPump (MFP) and the Air Revolution (AR).

The AR offers a larger base and a zero pressure-loss adapter and pressure release valve for

accurate air management and that is the one we received. The special Stop-Valve adapter eliminates air pressure loss during take off, compared to conventional suspension and floor pumps in which air inside the hose escapes causing pressure loss.

There are several other different models, but Niko assured us this would be a good one for our application.

After we got the unit opened we realized this was a high quality piece of gear! It had all metal fittings and felt heavy. Then after reading the literature, we realized this gear is engineered in Germany, land of Mercedes and BMW...quality stuff no doubt.

Checking out the contents, the AR comes with a small carrying bag and 3 extra valves for things like beach balls and bicycles. It's a nice extra touch.

The unit was easy to set up, and even easier to use with a built in pressure gauge. The unit has a small "stand" of sorts that you actually stand on and use your foot to pump it.

This is another major difference between a regular old bicycle pump and the AR. You basically secure the AR's stand with one foot, and pump with the other, this frees up your hands during the whole procedure so you can hold your bike up if you have no kickstand, too.

We measured the built in gauge against a Snap-On unit as well as a Blue Point low pressure gauge and it was within 1 pound accuracy, so that is really good. The dial is pretty small, so I like to use a separate air pressure gauge. But you don't need to if you don't want to.

We actually topped off our truck's tires with it as well, as the model we received will fill up to 70lbs of pressure. In a pinch it could save you some walking!

In conclusion, the AirRevolution IS a revolution in air pump technology.

It's small, affordable and high-quality. It's our first pick for a portable, manual air pump to bring to the track, and keep in your vehicle under the seat.
